2023 Highlights

Based on WHO messages, we continue to see:

- Inequality in the access of health services and health outcome around the World, especially for women & girls.
- Pregnancy & childbirth complication is 2nd leading of death among women & girls.
- In developed countries, half of women are prevented in making decision about having sex, contraceptives and health care
- All most 1 in 3 women have been experienced partners or no partner physical sexual abused

2023 Highlights

Protection against harmful practices

Harmful practices based on gender:

- Forced into the marriage
- Forcing them to join some type of region
- Using the prison as disciplinary



2023 Highlights

Indigenous & Vulnerable women

Indigenous & vulnerable women needs:

- In many countries, indigenous and vulnerable women & girls are living in poverty.
- Not only the lack of money, but also not having access to resources

2023 Highlights

Can we claim that HIV is a feminist issue?

- Nobody discusses anymore how HIV affects women and girls .
- Worldwide, 60 million females are impacted by cervical cancer. Additionally, the risk of cervical cancer is six times higher for women who are living with HIV.
- Community health workers (like us) has become like accountable instead of the state or country taking its responsibility

2023 Highlights

Progress

- 186% increase in tertiary education enrolment
- 117% increase in political representation
- 34% decrease in maternal mortality
- 9.2% increase in child immunizations
- 3.3% increase in contraceptive prevalence
